Subject: SFO staff remuneration

This request asked:

The total number of employees who received remuneration equal to, or in excess of £100,000 in 2013-14.

For those who received remuneration in excess of £150,000:

- *iii.* The remuneration received by the employee
- iv. An itemised list of expenses claims made by the employee. If an itemised list is not available, please provide the amount the employee claimed in expenses in 2013-14

The total number of permanent staff at the Serious Fraud Office who received such remuneration equal to, or in excess of, £100,000 in 2013-14 is eight. This includes staff who left the SFO through a voluntary exit scheme during the year, and standard employers' contributions to the civil service pension scheme.

Four of those eight received remuneration in excess of £150,000. Some information about remuneration is already published on the internet and in the SFO's annual report. This information is published in line with the Government's transparency policies.
